The Society of American Military Engineers (SAME) Sacramento and San Francisco Post present the 2016 Training and Business Opportunities Symposium, "Infrastructure and Resource Resilience: Preparing for the Future." The Symposium will be held August 30-31 at the Harper Alumni Center on the campus of California State University, Sacramento.

Over 20 speakers are expected to share their expertise during the two-day event. The symposium will consist of technical and business opportunity presentations.

Tuesday's presentations will focus on resource resilience with emphasis on water management and sustainability. This full day of presentations will drill into the details on legislative actions, the California Water Action Plan, funding sources, sustainable groundwater management, flood management programs, levee safety programs, desalination, recycling and environmental restorations.

Wednesday will be dedicated to large projects and military programs. Attendees will be updated on the California Water Fix project, the ongoing Isabella Dam Improvements and progress on the California High Speed Rail. Brigadier General (CA) Frank D. Emanuel, Director, Facilities and Infrastructure California Military Department will brief on the expansion of his program. The USACE, Navy, Coast Guard will brief on their regional programs.

Tuesday evening, the Symposium Social will take place at an offsite location. This will be an excellent opportunity for networking amongst attendees.
