The 2009 SAME Sacramento Post Young Members Career Fair and Forum will be held at the **University Union at Sacramento State University, in Sacramento, California on 19 November**. This year’s event includes two activities; a career fair held from 9:00 AM to 11:30 AM in the University Union Redwood Room, immediately followed by the Young Members Forum (YMF), held in the Orchard Suite of the University Union. The YMF will start at 11:30 AM and end no later than 1:30 PM. The topic for this year's YMF is "Engineering in the Future: Will you be Ready?" The event speaker is Dr. Ramzi Mahmood, Chair, Civil Engineering Department, Sacramento State University. The objective of the career fair is to provide local and regional businesses an opportunity to meet and evaluate graduating engineering students, while also providing students information and experience preparing them for their transition from academia to the business environment. The objective of the YMF is for young members, Army and Air Force Cadets and engineering students from U.C. Davis and Sacramento State University to have an opportunity to meet and greet members of industry, DOD civilians, and military officials and to learn about career opportunities and challenges in the engineering field in private and public sectors.

CAREER FAIR:

Sacramento State University students attending the Career Fair will consist primarily of engineering and science related under graduates seeking employment upon graduation and internships while in a student status. Company registration for the Sac State Career Fair will be \$50.00. Each company will be provided one table and chairs. Power outlets are scarce and may not be available for all tables. Registration is limited to the first 32 companies.
