#### What is Going on with the Endangered Species Act and How Will California Be Affected?

While the Endangered Species Act faces change in Washington, DC, California has been leading the country in infrastructure compliance. Regional conservation plans under the ESA have provided an efficient and comprehensive pathway for the compliance of capital improvement, infrastructure, and critical operations and maintenance activities. Dr. David Zippin is a nationally recognized expert on habitat conservation planning and frequent instructor on ESA compliance at the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service's national training center.
